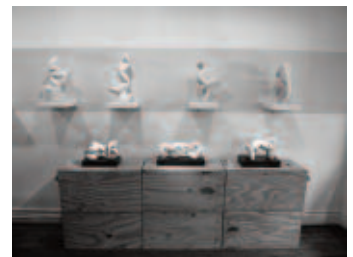

Stone carving is seeing a huge resurgence of interest at the moment, not least with the wonderful Henry Moore exhibition at Tate Britain until August 8th. Noticeable also is a greater, and growing, recognition of a generation of younger artists working in this demanding medium. From June 13th to July 11th William Peers will be one of 26 artists in 'On Form' at Asthall Manor in Oxfordshire (open Wed to Sun), where a fantastic range of stone sculpture may be explored in beautiful surroundings.

Currently on show at the gallery is Peers' extraordinary exhibition '100 Days: Sketched in Marble', a project in which the Sculptor undertook to carve one hundred sculptures each in a 10-hour period. The spontaneous carvings, and fresh ideas that resulted from this undertaking is an amazing story, mapping the thought processes of a dedicated Sculptor. The opening night saw nearly half the work sold, at prices from £1,100 - £1,800, and the show continues until May 15th.
